### Better Insulation

Our bonded sandwich panels, and fully insulated hatch doors keep the cabin warm in winter and cool in summer. In the XG range, the cabin is fully gas-free — no gas ventilation cut-outs, no insulation gaps, no dust creeping in. Just quiet, steady comfort.

### Smarter Energy Flow

Shorter, direct cabling means less loss from solar to batteries. What you collect, you keep — making every ray of sunlight count. Airflow and heat extraction around the battery management components, to ensure they run efficiently in the hottest climates.

### Efficient Climate Control

We choose air conditioners that sip power, not gulp it. In the XG range, the ducted split system

uses just 700W an hour — so you can run it longer, sleep cooler, and wake warmer without draining your bank.

### Balanced Energy Sources

Where others rely on just electric or diesel, Kokoda uses all three: Gas for hot water + outdoor cooking (outside the cabin, keeping it gas-free).

Diesel for reliable heating.

Electric (solar + lithium + inverter) for everything inside: aircon, appliances, lighting, comfort.

### The Outcome

With Kokoda, what most people see as endurance — blistering heat, biting cold, or days without sun — becomes simple, quiet, and comfortable. You spend more time off-grid, with less management and far less generator noise.
