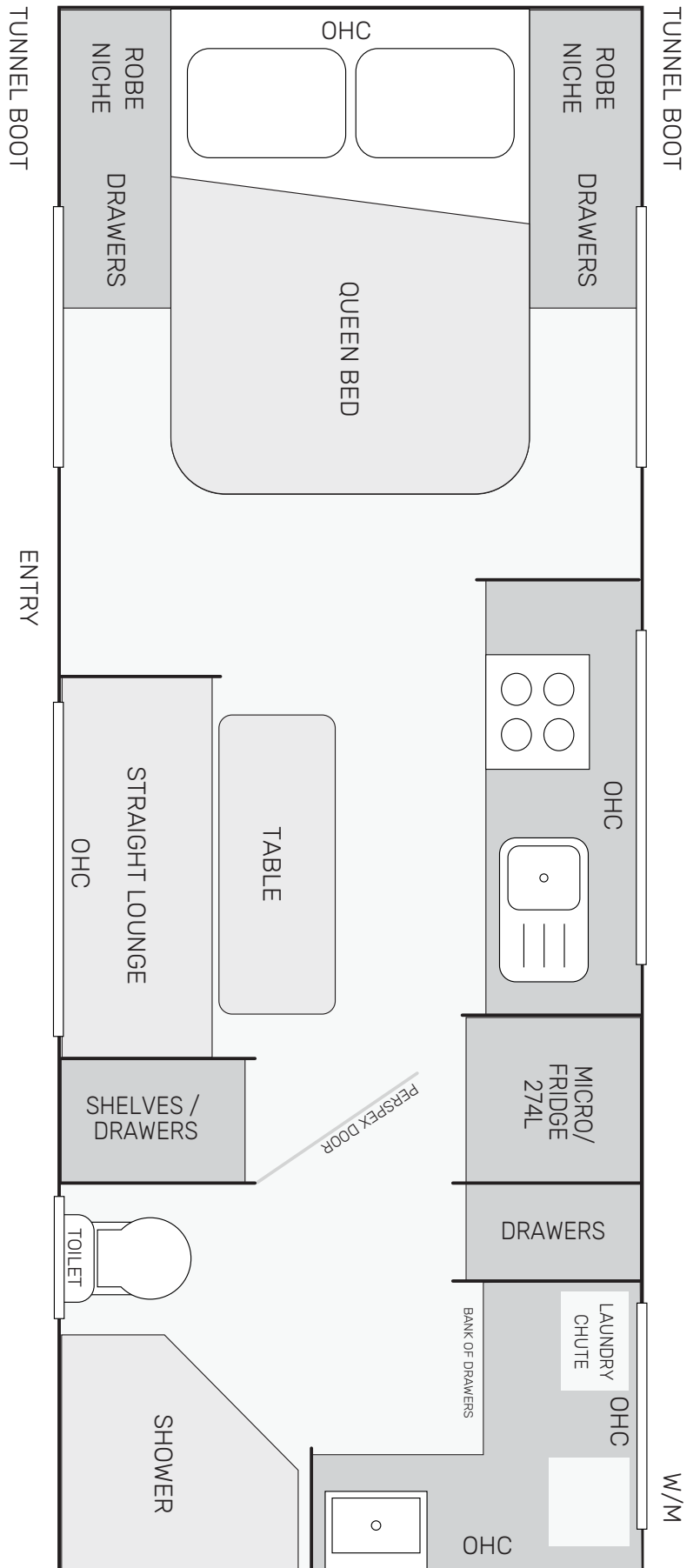

Why Is bonded construction better than screws?

1. How Does Bonded Construction Improve Caravan Strength?

Our frameless bonding process chemically fuses the walls, roof and floor into one seamless structure, eliminating weak points caused by screws and rivets that shift and loosen over time.

This results in a caravan that's stronger, more rigid and better at absorbing shocks from rough terrain.

2. What Makes It Ideal for Off-Road and Corrugated Roads?

- Vibration resistance – Bonded construction absorbs impacts, reducing internal movement and preventing fittings from coming loose.
- Less maintenance – No screws to tighten or check after rough road travel.

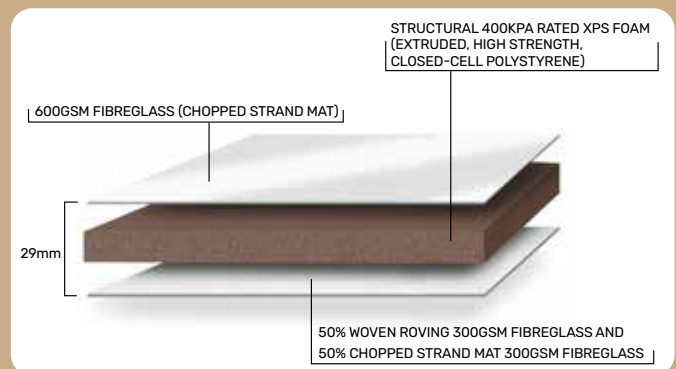

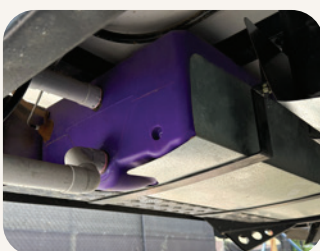
